## Fr. Stephen Writes

This weekend we celebrate the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit three Persons in one God. Though this mystery is beyond full human understanding, it reminds us of the perfect love and unity at the heart of our faith.

Next week the planned building works for the church building will shortly commence on the church premises as part of planned improvements to our building. During this period, there will be unavoidable disruption to the normal use of the church premises.
