This week the gospel brings us to the "Cleansing of the Temple," the scripture describes Jesus sending out the merchants and the money changers from the Jerusalem temple. This passage is foreshadowing the understanding of his body as the New Temple that replaces the physical one. "It has taken forty-six years to build this sanctuary: are you going to raise it up in three days?" But he was speaking of the sanctuary that was his body, and when Jesus rose from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this, and they believed the scripture and the words he had said."

Join Us At Footsteps On Thursday 13 November At 7.30pm

Our last event in the 2025 programme of inspiring talks in the parish centre of St Peter's, Green Lane, Hazel Grove SK7 4EA will be with Sister Alicia Perez who will be taking us on a pilgrimage - the famous Camino de Santiago. She is involved in the Camino Companions, which is a project of the Sisters Faithful Companions of Jesus in Santiago de Compostela to serve English-speaking pilgrims who arrive in Santiago after their long Camino journey. This group of Sisters and other volunteers welcome, listen to and accompany pilgrims as they share their unique stories and reflect on their experiences of the Camino. Sr Alicia has spent several summers in this ministry and will be speaking about the pilgrimage, its history, the enormous growth in recent decades and share the motivations and experiences of pilgrims today. You don't have to bring your hiking boots or rucksack - just yourself (and maybe a friend) to hear her talk about "Being a pilgrim". Footsteps provides an informal, caféstyle forum where we can listen to and reflect on various topics as we journey in our Christian faith.
